General Rules

This show is run under Gloucester Lodge Farm Rules & the associated affiliated societies email info@gloucesterlodgefarm.co.uk

Please note Championship Classes may not be in the original qualification rings and may not be judged by the original judge.

GLHT reserve the right to cancel, combine, split or amend all classes in the event of insufficient or excessive entries and adverse weather conditions. Once the show has started no refunds will be made on the day

All horses must be accompanied by their passport

No refunds will be made after the closing date

Every effort has been made to ensure that classes do not clash. However it is the competitor's responsibility to be at the correct ring at the correct time. No refunds will be made if competitors are late, do not turn up or do not attend at the correct ring in time for their class starting, *late entry into a class is at the judge's discretion only, competitors must ask the judge's permission, via the steward, before entering a class if it has already started.*

Rings / times are approximate and may change if one ring is empty before another any amendments etc. will be displayed in the secretary's caravan on the day of the show.

The organisers accept no responsibility for injury / damage/ loss of horses/property / people or pets.

All dogs must be kept on leads, and under control at all times, any dog mess should be picked up.

The judge's decision is final. Any objections / complaints about judging / stewards / other competitors should be lodged with the secretary in writing within 30 minutes of the Class ending along with a deposit of £30, which will be forfeited if the objection is over-ruled.

Appropriate showing attire & etiquette is required for all classes

Competitors must wear Riding Hats of current standard properly fastened at all times when mounted on the show field however seniors may wear showing head wear but do so at their own risk. All competitors must wear riding hats of current standard for all jumping competitions including WH jumping phase

Body protectors are advisory for jumping classes

Proper riding footwear must be worn at all times when mounted. Anyone wearing muckers, wellies or trainers will not be allowed to compete.

Excess use of whips or spurs will not be allowed - anyone who is considered to be using them to excess will be asked to remove them or will be required to leave the field. In addition juniors under 16 may only ride in spurs with the Secretary's approval.

Stallions should be handled/ridden by competent adults. Anyone bringing a Stallion should advise the secretary / judge on arrival to show ground or ring

No galloping on the show field.

The practice fence is provided as a warm-up facility for competitors ONLY and must only be used as such. Anyone found using the fence in excess will be asked to leave the show field immediately.

Horses / ponies must be in good health, 4 years & over for ridden and 6 months and over for in-hand.

Minimum age of handler for in hand classes is 9 years however all juniors may be accompanied by an adult if they wish Any horse or pony considered by a judge or official not fit to compete will be disqualified from the competition and no refund will be made under any circumstances

Competitors must be considerate to spectators on foot when riding their horse / pony.

No horses or ponies allowed in the no horse zones for any reason

Anyone considered to be riding dangerously will be required to leave the field immediately and forfeit any remaining entry money.

No horses or ponies to be left unattended at any time

Under no circumstances are any horses allowed on the Cross Country Course without prior arrangement. Anyone found riding around the XC course will be required to leave the field immediately and forfeit any remaining entry money.

A photographer will be present at this event by entering this competition you agree to be photographed this includes under 18's

By entering the showground spectators and competitors agree to the above.

COLOURED HORSE AND PONY SOCIETY (UK) RULES

"This show is affiliated to The Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Affiliation No. 19028

Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete. However in order to Qualify both Owner and Rider/Exhibitor need to be a current showing member and present their valid Qualifier card IN THE RING for signing by the judge. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for appropriate qualifier card. This Show is a Qualifier for the 2019 CHAPS (UK) Championship Show – date TBC. PLEASE ENSURE YOU HAVE YOUR 2019 QUALIFIER CARD WITH YOU. APPLICATIONS FOR THIS AVAILABLE FROM EARLY AUGUST. The following classes are CHAPS (UK) Qualifiers [Show Secretary to insert class numbers]. For full rulings and information on competition/qualification, please refer to the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook; or visit www.chapsuk.com for rulings.

All stallions, 4 years old and over entering these classes must be graded with CHAPS (UK). All stallions must wear Stallion ID Discs in the ring without exception

RoR OPEN In Hand Show Series Qualifier

Open to all RoR and NR registered horses, 3yrs and over, fillies, mares and geldings.

Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.

This class is a qualifier for the RoR OPEN In Hand Showing Series FINAL

The first three go forward to the final at the RoR Championships, Aintree in August 2018 or 2019 for shows after 1st August 2018.

This class is a qualifier for the RoR OPEN In Hand Showing Series FINAL

Rosettes 1st - 6th.

Prizes - 1st £30 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £20, 3rd £10, 4th £10

RoR AMATEUR Ridden Show Series Qualifier

Open to all RoR and NR registered horses, 4yrs and over, mares and geldings, owned, produced and ridden by an Amateur.

The Series is open to AMATEURS only – those employed in racing will be allowed to compete. Class will be judged under 'riding horse' format without 'type' being taken into consideration.

Blemishes caused through racing will be ignored.

This class is a qualifier for the RoR Amateur Ridden Show Series FINAL.

The Judge will not ride at the qualifier but will ride in the final.

The first three go forward to the final at the RoR National Championships at Aintree in August 2018 or 2019 for shows after 1st August 2018 to the 31st July 2019.

Rosettes 1st - 6th.

Prizes - 1st £40 plus RoR jacket, 2nd £30, 3rd £20, 4th £10

Amateur definition:

An amateur is a person who for the purpose of RoR classes does not/has not during the current season or previous season:

Engage (d) in breeding, livery, buying or selling, dealing or hiring horses (for the show ring) in a commercial capacity. Horses must not have been stabled at or reside in a Professional Producer's/Trainer's yard (in the current season or previous season).

Riders must not have ridden any animals produced by a Professional/Trainer in the current or previous season.

Horses and riders must not have received any help from a Professional Producer/Trainer at a SHOW in the current or previous season.

Horses must not have been ridden at a show by a rider who has ridden for a Professional/Producer Trainer in the current or previous season.

Any breaches of this ruling will be taken seriously and will result in disqualification from future classes.

TSR Showing Finals

This show is a qualifier for the 2018 TSR Showing Finals. Qualify and enter ANY of the Finals Central, East Anglia, North West, North East, South East, South, Wales & South West or Scottish. You Do Not have to be a TSR member to qualify or enter a final. The Rider/Handler qualifies and can enter any horse/pony in any number of Finals!

TSR Riders Finals - 1st & 2nd riders qualify and will receive a qualification card in the ring.

TSR In Hand Finals - The two highest placed Handlers with a TSR In Hand Card will qualify in any In Hand class.

Handlers MUST have their cards signed in the ring by the judge/steward, cards are available FREE from the TSR website. Full details at <http://www.theshowingregister.co.uk/>

TSR Medal Awards - TSR members can collect qualification cards & signatures and redeem for a TSR Medal see TSR website for details.

BSHA Grass Roots Champs - With a TSR qualification card you can also enter the BSHA Grass Roots Champs in Sept at Addington Equestrian Centre - You do not have to be a BSHA member to qualify or enter the final.

BEST RIDING/PONY CLUB TYPE HORSE AND PONY

To be judged on manners and suitability for Riding Club and Pony Club activities. Combination will be required to do an individual show, no jumping. 1st, 2nd, & 3rd, in each class to qualify for the FINAL to be held at Glendale Show on Monday 27th August at the Showfield, Wooler.

Class 8 Best Riding/Pony Club type pony. 4 years or over, not exceeding 14.2hh (147cm), rider any age.

Class 27 Best Riding/Pony Club type horse. 4 years or over, exceeding 14.2hh (147cm), rider any age.

Competitors do not need to be a Member of a Pony Club or a Riding Club and there will be £100 prize money for each Championship class at Glendale Show, split over the top 3.
