- **We are not providing bibs at this event only paper numbers. We have purchased a small number of BE bibs which can be purchased from the caravan for £10. While stocks last**
- *If you are eliminated at any point during the competition, if we feel it is safe to and you want to continue, this will be allowed, however, you must be considerate to riders who are still in the competition and the safety of yourself and your horse.*
 - **Falls – If you fall off at any point during the competition, if directed by the jump judge or steward, you are advised to see first aid to confirm that it is safe for you to continue. If your horse falls you are immediately eliminated and cannot continue.**
- *You are **NOT** allowed to use clocks, watches or time pieces that can be stopped and started. Please be careful of people on the course, at the start and finish timing you as they may get you eliminated*
- **In the interests of rider safety you must always be going forward at a cross country jump higher than 18 ins / 45 cms. Hesitation or jumping from a standstill will result in a refusal given**
- **As per BE Rule 5.8 Electronic and other Devices.**

No receiving, recording, transmitting or monitoring device maybe be used by a competitor during any phase of the event.
